Gatewatching, Not Gatekeeping: Collaborative Online News

gatekeeping selects not only 'all the news that's fit to print', according to the gatekeepers' intuition of what their audience is interested in, but more precisely 'all the news that's fit to print and that can be made to fit into the available channel space' News coverage in traditional news media is always
